Please use the CSS border property instead.</th></tr><tr><th>buffered</th><th><audio>,<video></th><th>Contains the time range of already buffered media.</th></tr><tr><th>challenge</th><th><command>,<input></th><th>Indicates whether the element should be checked on page load.</th></tr><tr><th>cite</th><th><q></th><th>Contains a URI which points to the source of the quote or change.</th></tr><tr><th>class</th><th>Global attribute</th><th>Often used with CSS to style elements with common properties.</th></tr><tr><th>code</th><th><applet></th><th>This attribute gives the absolute or relative URL of the directory where applets' .class files referenced by the code attribute are stored.</th></tr><tr><th>color</th><th></th><th></th></tr><tr><th>cols</th><th><textarea></th><th>Defines the number of columns in a textarea.</th></tr><tr><th>colspan</th><th>,</th><th>The colspan attribute defines the number of columns a cell should span.</th></tr><tr><th>content</th><th><meta></th><th>A value associated with http-equiv or name depending on the context.</th></tr></tbody></table></script>
