

MV Command

mv command is used to move file from one location to another location using mv command in linux. another use of mv command is to rename a specified file name in linux,

Syntax

```
$mv [file_name] [destination_path]
```

Move a File

```
$mv file1.txt demodir
```

Rename a File

```
$mv file1.txt file2.txt
```

Options

Sr.No	Options	Descriptions
01	-b	make a backup copy is renamed with file1.txt
02	-f	remove existing destination file without prompting for confirmation.
03	-help	display available option.
04	-i	prompt before overwriting existing destination file.
05	-v	show messages explaining what the command is doing.
