

PHP FTP Functions

Function	Description
<code>ftp_alloc</code>	Allocates space for a file to be uploaded
<code>ftp_cdup</code>	Changes to the parent directory
<code>ftp_chdir</code>	Changes the current directory on a FTP server
<code>ftp_chmod</code>	Set permissions on a file via FTP
<code>ftp_close</code>	Closes an FTP connection
<code>ftp_connect</code>	Opens an FTP connection
<code>ftp_delete</code>	Deletes a file on the FTP server
<code>ftp_exec</code>	Requests execution of a command on the FTP server
<code>ftp_fget</code>	Downloads a file from the FTP server and saves to an open file
<code>ftp_fput</code>	Uploads from an open file to the FTP server
<code>ftp_get_option</code>	Retrieves various runtime behaviours of the current FTP stream
<code>ftp_get</code>	Downloads a file from the FTP server
<code>ftp_login</code>	Logs in to an FTP connection
<code>ftp_mdtm</code>	Returns the last modified time of the given file
<code>ftp_mkdir</code>	Creates a directory
<code>ftp_nb_continue</code>	Continues retrieving/sending a file (non-blocking)
<code>ftp_nb_fget</code>	Retrieves a file from the FTP server and writes it to an open file (non-blocking)
<code>ftp_nb_fput</code>	Stores a file from an open file to the FTP server (non-blocking)
<code>ftp_nb_get</code>	Retrieves a file from the FTP server and writes it to a local file (non-blocking)
<code>ftp_nb_put</code>	Stores a file on the FTP server (non-blocking)
<code>ftp_nlist</code>	Returns a list of files in the given directory
<code>ftp_pasv</code>	Turns passive mode on or off
<code>ftp_put</code>	Uploads a file to the FTP server
<code>ftp_pwd</code>	Returns the current directory name
<code>ftp_quit</code>	Alias of <code>ftp_close</code>
<code>ftp_raw</code>	Sends an arbitrary command to an FTP server
<code>ftp_rawlist</code>	Returns a detailed list of files in the given directory
<code>ftp_rename</code>	Renames a file or a directory on the FTP server
<code>ftp_rmdir</code>	Removes a directory
<code>ftp_set_option</code>	Set miscellaneous runtime FTP options
<code>ftp_site</code>	Sends a SITE command to the server
<code>ftp_size</code>	Returns the size of the given file
<code>ftp_ssl_connect</code>	Opens an Secure SSL-FTP connection
<code>ftp_systype</code>	Returns the system type identifier of the remote FTP server
